Length

- Reviews of teaching materials/resources: 350-450 words, unless there is something exceptional to be said about them which takes longer.
- Reviews of books for young people: 300- 400 words.

Content (teaching book / resources)

Reviews should briefly outline or indicate the nature of the contents of the text; however, the review should not be simply a description of the contents. Reviewers should try to assess the quality of the text and its contribution to knowledge or teaching practice, setting it in the context of current theory or practice and/or previous texts or debates. In addition, reviewers may wish to comment on the intended readership and possible reception of the text, and on the specific circumstances in which the text was written or published.
